Scoping

- In some cases specific studies can be useful to facilitate an informed decision eg
 - Details of forest product trade flows
 - Stakeholder mapping
 - Impact assessment
- On EU side identification of potential lead Member State that will work with the Commission (where possible)

Information

- "V" of VPA
- Usually informal expression of interest from country
- Briefing meetings EUDel, DEVCO or ENV, EFI; EFI Briefing Notes, EU NGOs, private sector
- Describe process but try to avoid being too prescriptive on content
- Information to as many stakeholder groups as possible, not just govt.



Decision to open negotiations

- Different forms
 - Meeting and joint press release: Minister and Commissioner
 - Letter to Head of Delegation
 - Memorandum of Understanding
- ENV or DEVCO lead



- Different levels
 - Senior Officials Meeting
 - Technical Working Group
 - Joint Expert Meetings
- Mainly in partner country but some sessions should take place in Brussels



- Negotiation team: partner country
 - EU can encourage but ultimately the composition of the team is up to the govt
 - Aim for a team including representatives of different Ministries concerned, NGOs, private sector federations. In Liberia community representatives were also nominated.
 - Structures for reporting and consensus building between stakeholder groups
 - Good facilitators invaluable



- Negotiation team: EU
 - European Commission has a formal Council to mandate to negotiate for the EU
 - Member States invited in-country and in Brussels, generally one or two take a more detailed interest
 - Commission reports on progress to Council WG on Forests
 - Ad-hoc FLEGT group for more detailed coordn
 - EFI experts provide technical advice
 - No NGOs or private sector in EU team!



- Key issues can include
 - Definition of legal timber
 - Description future Timber Legality Assurance System
 - Structures for reporting, independent monitoring and governance of the VPA
 - Indication of reforms that will be made
 - Soft references to development cooperation
 - EU market incentives often sought...

Signature and ratification

- Trade legal base: signature and ratification only done at EU level – no MS ratification
- Initialling
- Legal scrubbing
- Commission proposal for signature
- Approval by Council and signature (photo op)
- European Parliament consent
- Ratification
- Publication in OJ



Interim body for coordination EU- partner country

Implementation

- Often a loss of momentum after negotiations
- EU or MS programming of cooperation can lag behind
- Try to keep momentum and focus on implementation
- Development of IT systems has proved difficult
- Some technical assistance possible from EFI FLEGT Facility
- Greater role of Delegation vis a vis HQ



Implementation

- Work also underway on EU side to have procedures in place and penalties established
- Electronic FLEGT licenses
- Independent Market Monitor



FLEGT Licensing Scheme Operational

- Independent assessment of Timber Legality Assurance System (ToRs in VPA)
- Assuming report positive decision to go "live" in Joint Implementation Cttee with proposed date
- EU side: FLEGT Regulation Annexes must be amended through a formal procedure
- Annual reports
